

Felted Little Bag



A You Can Do It Pattern

This Pattern makes a wonderful Make-up , Notions or Trinket Bag

These Patterns are designed for those of You who have been making Scarves & Hats For all eternity and are ready (You are Ready!) to move up to the next level. They are written with very little Knitter's Lingo and in long unabbreviated format.

The bag is Sooo Quick and makes a Great Gift. So Here we go.....

Material: About 250 yards total of 3 colors or more all of the same weight (size of yarn) . My Favorite thing to do is to get a bunch of left over yarns and one skein of new yarn together and use that. Tap Into your own Creativity .As long as it is wool, alpaca, silk, mohair, or other natural fiber you're okay. No cotton , nylon, polyester or other plastics.

Gauge : You not making mittens, sweaters or socks. Forget about it for this Project! It will fit in your hand no matter what yarn you use. I like one stand of worsted weight (4-5 stitches to the inch or two strands on any thing held together of smaller yarn (6-10 stitches to the inch) . You are going to wash this in very hot, soapy water anyway and shrink it all up. Felting hides a multitude of sins . Perfectionism not necessary for this project (that's why we love felting!)

Needles: One 16 inch long circular needles in almost any size bigger than a #9 .I love a #10 1/2 Bamboo.

If you learned to knit on sticks it's time to move up & onward . This one cannot be made in any realistic amount of time on sticks or Double Pointed Needles & knitting in the Round (a big tube) is quicker , no sewing and no side seams which tend to give us grief when piecing together. Trust me.

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
